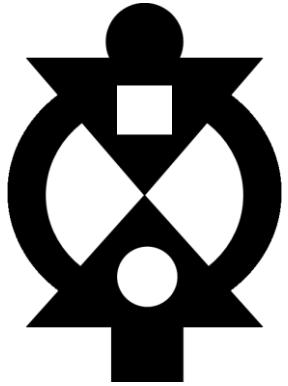

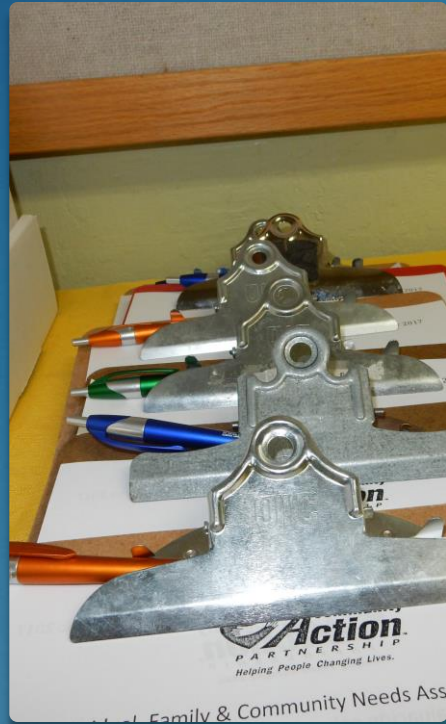

- ▶ MCCAP engages in **THREE main activities** to achieve the agency mission of:

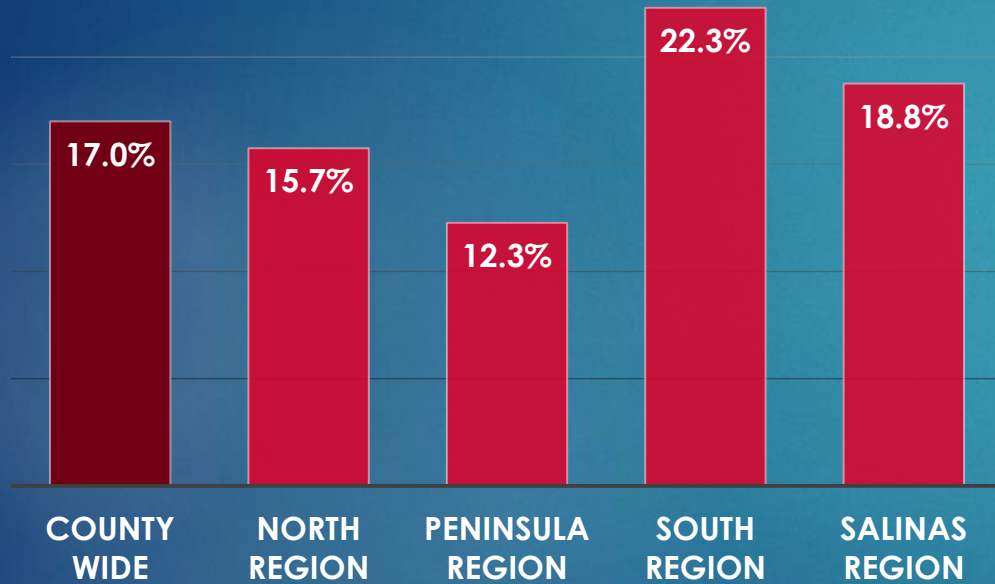
Assessing the needs of the low-income people in Monterey County and develop, maintain, and evaluate community services that empower low-income individuals and families to improve their quality of life.

- 1) Contract with local non-profit and public agencies for services
- 2) Engage in collaborations with community stakeholders
- 3) Advocate and participate in community activities that support the low-income community

Consumer Identified Service Priorities

Services for Youth – educational and/or recreational

Housing & Utility – unit search and/or payment assistance

Food Bank/Food Pantry – access to food and/or meals

Child Care Services – free or reduced cost programs

Health & Wellbeing – access to physical and/or mental health programs

Violence Prevention/Intervention – domestic violence or gang violence

Transportation – access to free/low cost and/or expanded regions of county

Adult/Parent Education – high school equivalency and/or parenting classes

Employment Support – services that support job attainment and/or retention

Budgeting & Tax Services – financial literacy and/or free tax preparation programs

Homeless Services/Emergency Shelter – access to emergency shelter and/or services for homeless



Next Steps

- ▶ **2018-2019 Community Action Plan presented for approval by Monterey County Board of Supervisors**
- ▶ **Approved Plan must be delivered to the California Department of Community Services and Development by June 30, 2017.**
- ▶ **This Plan will be used as a guide for the provision of supportive community services to low-income people in Monterey County for Calendar Years 2018-2019.**
- ▶ **MCCAP will release a Request for Proposals (RFP) to community based organizations for provision of services that meet the priorities documented in this plan.**
- ▶ **MCCAP staff will oversee multiple contracts for these services for 2018-2019 and manage data regarding outcomes to be delivered to the State.**
- ▶ **MCCAP Commissioners are able to engage in all processes and provide oversight**
