AND
Amar Forensics, hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR"**

Language and Insurance Modifications Requested to Standard County Agreement

CONTRACTOR requests the following language changes to the County's Standard Contract. This change has been discussed with CONTRACTOR, and CONTRACTOR is aware that these changes will require Board of Supervisors Approval.

Section 8.0 Indemnification is hereby changed to read

CONTRACTOR agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the County, its officers, agents, and employees from and against any and all claims, liabilities, losses, damages to property, injuries to or death of persons, court costs, and reasonable attorney fees occurring or resulting from the performance of this agreement, including the actions or inactions of the CONTRACTOR, its officers, employees, agents, and subcontractors, unless such claims, liabilities, or losses arise solely out of the negligence or willful misconduct of the County. Similarly, County agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless CONTRACTOR from and against any and all claims, liabilities, losses, damages to property, injuries to or death of persons, court costs, and reasonable attorney fees occurring or resulting from the performance of this agreement, including the actions or inactions of County, its officers, agents, and employees, unless such claims, liabilities, or losses arise solely out of the negligence or willful misconduct of CONTRACTOR.

COUNTY agrees to modify the Other 'Insurance' Requirements for the CONTRACTOR by modifying Section 9.03 of the COUNTY Standard Agreement for this Agreement as follows:

Workers' Compensation Insurance Exemption

The CONTRACTOR does not employ anyone. Accordingly, Workers' Compensation coverage requirements are therefore waived for this CONTRACTOR under this Agreement.

However, should at any time during the term of this Agreement CONTRACTOR employs anyone for the services of this Agreement, this modification will be re-evaluated, CONTRACTOR may be required to comply with the Workers' Compensation insurance requirement.
