

IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING COVID-19 AND PARTICIPATION IN THE MEETING OF THE FORT ORD COMMITTEE

The Fort Ord Committee will be conducted via teleconference. The meeting will have no physical location in order to minimize the spread of the COVID-19 virus, in accordance with the State of Emergency proclaimed by Governor Newsom on March 4, 2020, Executive Order N-29-20 issued by Governor Newsom on March 17, 2020, and the Shelter in Place Order issued by the Monterey County Health Officer on March 17, 2020, as may be periodically amended.

To participate in this Monterey County Fort Ord Committee meeting, the public are invited to observe and address telephonically or electronically.

To select the "raise hand" option, click on the 'participants' icon at the bottom of your Zoom screen, then click the "raise hand" icon next to your name.
