
Board Referral No 2022.04

- Boronda is located directly west of Salinas, is approximately 1 square mile and is home to over 3,000 residents and 30 businesses.
- Relocation of Salinas Valley Solid Waste Authority (SVSWA) to Republic Services yard on Madison Lane
- Research shows Boronda Road crossing closed in 1982 after Davis Road Overpass constructed
- Revisit the Rossi Road extension plan to modernize and improve traffic circulation in the Boronda Area.

Process

- Work in collaboration for a comprehensive analysis after meeting with stakeholders
- Resources Required
 - Staffing HCD, PWFP, County Counsel, City of Salinas, SVSWA, Republic, TAMC
 - Cost Still being determined.
 - > 2010 Salinas TFO estimate = \$2.5 Mil (for two-lane facility)
 - County estimate = \$4 Mil (2003 dollars)
- Timing
 - Return to the Board June 2022 (target)

Challenges

- Coordination with stakeholders presents complexities including defining the appropriate agency to act as the lead agency (e.g., County, City or TAMC).
- Costs/funding
- CEQA/Environmental
