**Adopt Resolution No. 20 - 294:**

- a. Find that approval of Fire Recovery Guidelines is an emergency action which qualifies as a Statutory Exemption pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15269;
- b. Approve Fire Recovery Guidelines for the River, Carmel and Dolan Fires to support the processing of permits for the rebuilding of structures destroyed or damaged by the three 2020 Fires for a 5-year period (September 15, 2025); and
- c. Authorize the Director of Resource Management Agency to extend the five-year timeframe for applying these Guidelines, not to exceed September 15, 2030.

Planning Areas: Toro Area Plan, Cachagua Area Plan, Carmel Valley Master Plan, Big Sur Land Use Plan, Greater Monterey Peninsula Area Plan

Proposed CEQA Action: Emergency action which qualifies as a Statutory Exemption pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15269.


