AMENDMENT No. 3 TO PARAMEDIC SERVICE PROVIDER AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY OF MONTEREY AND PEBBLE BEACH COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

THIS AMENDMENT No. 3 is made to the Paramedic Service Provider Agreement ("AGREEMENT") by and between the Pebble Beach Community Services District hereinafter referred to as "PROVIDER," and the County of Monterey, a political subdivision of the State of California, acting through its Emergency Medical Services Agency (EMSA), hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY."

WHEREAS, on or about July 1, 2018, 2018, COUNTY and PROVIDER entered into an AGREEMENT for the provision of paramedic services in the County of Monterey for a period from July 1, 2018 to January 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on or about February 13, 2020, COUNTY and PROVIDER executed AMENDMENT #1 to extend the AGREEMENT on the same terms and conditions for a period of two years to January 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, on or about March 10, 2022, COUNTY and PROVIDER executed AMENDMENT #2 to extend the AGREEMENT on the same terms and conditions for a period of two years to July 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and PROVIDER wish to amend the AGREEMENT to extend the AGREEMENT on the same terms and conditions for a period of two years and eleven (11) months to June 30, 2025.

NOW THEREFORE, COUNTY and PROVIDER hereby agree to amend the AGREEMENT in the following manner:

- 1. Section 1 of Term of Agreement shall be amended by removing "Once signed by the authorized representatives for all parties, this agreement becomes effective at 12:00 a.m. on July 1, 2018 and shall continue until July 31, 2022," and replacing it with "Once signed by the authorized representatives for all parties, this agreement becomes effective at 12:00 a.m. on July 1, 2018 and shall continue until June 30, 2025."
- 2. Amend Section 3.2 to read as follows:
 - 3.2 PROVIDER may also provide Basic Life Support and Advanced Life Support on automatic aid and mutual aid calls within and outside of Monterey County. This shall not be construed to allow PROVIDER to provide Advanced Life Support on a routine or long-term basis in areas other than those identified in "Primary Service Area" identified on the map and attached as Exhibit A until patient care is transferred to another authorized provider or authorized receiving facility, pursuant to EMS Agency policies and procedures. Under the umbrella of providing mutual aid, the PROVIDER may on occasion have a paramedic with current Monterey County paramedic accreditation act in

a paramedic capacity while working in other areas of the county when the approved county "Paramedic Provider Authorized Stock (4010)" equipment arrives at the scene of an emergency incident.

- 3. Except as provided herein, all remaining terms, conditions and provisions of the AGREEMENT, AMENDMENT No. 1, and AMENDMENT No. 2 shall continue in full force and effect.
- 4. A copy of AMENDMENT No. 3 shall be attached to the original AGREEMENT dated July 1, 2018 and shall be incorporated therein as if fully set forth in the AGREEMENT.
