WHEREAS, the Food Stamp Act of 1964 created a permanent national nutrition program, known locally as CalFresh; and

WHEREAS, CalFresh continues to be one of the most important ways to fight hunger in the community; and

WHEREAS, Monterey County is committed to ensuring low-income children, families and individuals receive the nutrition assistance they need; and

WHEREAS, CalFresh provides nutrition assistance to over 50,000 residents in Monterey County providing over \$90 million in nutrition assistance per year; and

WHEREAS, Monterey County Department of Social Services continues community outreach and enrollment efforts to populations historically underserved; and

WHEREAS, CalFresh plays a valuable role in the local economy by generating approximately \$1.79 for every \$1 of CalFresh benefit utilized;
