AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF MONTEREY, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 12.12.010 OF THE MONTEREY COUNTY CODE RELATING TO SPEED LIMITS ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS

County Counsel Summary

This ordinance amends section 12.12.010 of the Monterey County Code to revise the speed limit for a section of Inter-Garrison Road in the East Garrison area of the unincorporated area of the County of Monterey.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE AND FINDINGS. Pursuant to Article XI, section 7 of the California Constitution, the County of Monterey may adopt and enforce ordinances and regulations not in conflict with general laws to protect and promote the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens. Pursuant to California Vehicle Code sections 22349 and 22358 (a) and the California Manual of Traffic Control Devices, the County of Monterey may by ordinance determine and declare upon the basis of an engineering and traffic survey a prima facie speed limit of less than fifty-five miles per hour on Inter-Garrison Road if the speed limit is appropriate to facilitate the orderly movement of traffic and is reasonable and safe.

SECTION 2. Section 12.12.010 of the Monterey County Code is amended to delete the following paragraph:

Inter-Garrison Road, from its intersection with Reservation Road generally southwest to the terminus of the County right-of-way, thirty-five miles per hour;

SECTION 3. Section 12.12.010 of the Monterey County Code is amended to add the following paragraph:

Inter-Garrison Road, from its intersection with Reservation Road generally southwest to the terminus of the County right-of-way, forty-five miles per hour;

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective on the thirty-first day following its adoption.
