

E-Form Phase 3 Development Costs and Maintenance 3-Year Budget

The e-Forms system is a suite of cloud-based applications designed to facilitate and assist taxpayers with downloadable, fillable, county customized forms. Phase 1 and 2 applications with 82 forms went live in January 2015, and within 11 weeks more than 74,000 forms were downloaded statewide among participating counties.

The proposal at this time is to complete the final development phase of the initial project, while continuing to support usage of the current e-Forms system. Phase 3 will include form data structure and standardization, online filing for supported BOE and CAA forms, county portal expansion to support forms data downloads and various county options, enhanced reports, and BOE/CAA County forms collaboration portal.

The following budget includes the Phase 3 enhancement costs in the 2015-16 fiscal year. The budget estimates for the 2016-17 and 2017-18 are for on-going maintenance and support after Phase 3 is complete. The shared cost allocation on the following page reflects the proportioned distribution among the 38 participating counties.

The following page is a schedule detailing cost share for each participating county based on the above budget. Since individual costs are a function of county size and the total number of participating counties, the final budget share changed somewhat from the preliminary estimates. Individual county shares are based upon the number of parcels/units reported by the Board of Equalization on Table "D", under 601 Roll for 2013-14. Each county will soon receive an invoice from the CAA Treasurer (Sacramento Assessor) for their share of costs to participate in this re-engineering and continuation project.

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SDR/e-SDR Version 2.0 Re-Engineering Project and Maintenance 3-Year Budget

As you know, the need to re-engineer the SDR system is driven by the age of the system, which is more than 10 years, in addition to Microsoft's decision not to support Windows Server 2003 in July 2015, and its intent to end support for .Net 2.0 in April 2016. There are eight servers relying on Windows Server 2003 and ending support for .Net 2.0 will affect the entire SDR system.

The proposal at this time is to update the SDR system to a cloud infrastructure to reduce costs and embrace new web standards for a richer user experience on desktops and mobile devices. Version 2.0 is expected to last for the next 6-10 years and provide a total savings of \$550,000.¹

The following budget distributes the development costs (\$350,000) over fiscal years 2015-16 and 2016-17. The ten counties participation in SDR but not e-SDR have a reduced share of development and maintenance costs. Version 2.0 is planned to be finished in time for the 2017 filing period. The third-year budget represents on-going maintenance and support after development is completed.
