<u>Recommendation 2:</u> Monterey County District Attorney's Office pursue an increase for the Real Estate Fraud Trust Fund fee to \$10 per document, if needed, to fund the cost of a forensic examination:

Response R-2: This recommendation will not be implemented. Two years ago, the District Attorney's Office appeared before the Board of Supervisors to request and successfully obtain a \$6 increase for the recording of those documents and instruments specified under Government Code Section 27388. The current fee is \$9. At this time, the District Attorney's Office does not intend to seek an increase to \$10 per document..

<u>Recommendation 3:</u> Monterey County District Attorney's Office, in cooperation with the Monterey County Recorder's Office, immediately create / obtain a current list of known robo-signers:

Response R-3: This recommendation requires further analysis. The District Attorney's Office will work with the Recorder's Office to create a list of suspected robo-signers as soon as practicable.
