WHEREAS, Dr. Woodson initiated Black History Week, February 12, 1926; and for many years, the second week of February, chosen so as to coincide with the birthdays of Frederick Douglas and Abraham Lincoln, was celebrated by African Americans in the United States, and
<b>WHEREAS</b> , in 1976, as part of the nation's bicentennial, Black History Week was expanded and became established as Black History Month, and is now celebrated all over North America and
WHEREAS, Hallowed Grounds: Sites of African American Memories is the national theme fo African American History Month, which is observed in Monterey County to encourage al citizens to learn about and appreciate the African American story; and
WHEREAS, the Association for the Study of African American Life & History has selected this annual theme to bring attention to the centennial celebration of the National Park Service and the more than twenty-five sites and the Underground Railroad Network to Freedom that are part of America's hallowed grounds, including the home of the father of black history, Dr. Carter G Woodson; and
<b>WHEREAS</b> , while the observance of Black History Month calls our Nation's attention to the continued need to battle racism and to build a society that lives up to it democratic ideals.
