WHEREAS, the parties wish to further amend the Agreement to provide additional environmental services including the preparation of a biological memorandum regarding the California Tiger Salamander; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to further amend the Agreement to extend the term to June 30, 2012 to continue to provide tasks associated with project management, preliminary engineering and reports, and final design of the Peach Tree Road Bridge Replacement Project at Pancho Rico Creek, County No. 412.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to further amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Amend Paragraph 1, "Services to Be Provided", to read as follows:

The County hereby engages CONTRACTOR to perform, and CONTRACTOR hereby agrees to perform, the services described in Exhibits A, A-1 and A-2 in conformity with the terms of this Agreement. The services are generally described as follows: Provide Project Management, Preliminary Engineering and reports, Final Design, hazardous material field investigation services, and additional environmental services including the preparation of a biological memorandum regarding the California Tiger Salamander, for the Peach Tree Road Bridge Replacement Project at Pancho Rico Creek, County No. 412, State Bridge No. 44C-0151.

County shall pay the CONTRACTOR in accordance with the payment provisions set forth in Exhibits A, A-1 and A-2, subject to the limitations set forth in this Agreement. The total amount payable by County to CONTRACTOR under this Agreement is amended to increase the total amount payable to CONTRACTOR by \$5,750, for a total not to exceed the sum of \$251,339.

3. Amend the first sentence of Paragraph 3, "Term of Agreement", to read as follows:

The term of this Agreement is from <u>February 9, 2009</u> to <u>June 30, 2012</u>, unless sooner terminated pursuant to the terms of this Agreement.

- 4. Amend Paragraph 4, "Additional Provisions/Exhibits", by adding "Exhibit A-2, "Scope of Services/Payment Provisions".
- 5. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain unchanged and in full force.
- 6. This Amendment No. 2 shall be attached to the Agreement and incorporated therein as if fully set forth in the Agreement.

This extension does not apply to the limit or limits specified by any law governing motor carriers of passengers or property.
- (2) Provide the minimum amounts and types of other coverages, such as nofault, required of out-of-state vehicles by the jurisdiction where the covered "auto" is being used.

We will not pay anyone more than once for the same elements of loss because of these extensions.

### B. Exclusions

This insurance does not apply to any of the following:
