CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILD SUPPORT SERVICES OF MONTEREY COUNTY

(a)—The Political Reform Act of 1974, (Government Code sections 81000, et seq.)₅ requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate <u>c</u>Conflict of <u>i</u>Interest <u>c</u>Codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, <u>2 Cal. Code of Regs.</u> section 18730<u>of Title 2</u> <u>of the California Code of Regulations</u>, which contains the terms of a standard<u>model <u>c</u>Conflict of <u>i</u>Interest <u>c</u>Code <u>that</u>, which can be incorporated by reference <u>in a Department's code</u>. After <u>public</u> <u>notice and hearing</u>, and which may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act_<u>after public</u> notice and hearings. Therefore, the terms o<u>ff 2 Cal. Code of Regs</u>. section 18730 <u>of title 2 of the California Code of Regulations</u> and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission, along with the attached Appendi<u>cess</u> <u>designating positions</u> and <u>establishing in which</u> <u>officials and employees are designated and</u> disclosure categories are <u>set forth and</u> hereby incorporated by reference and <u>together</u> constitute the Conflict of Interest Code of the Department of Child Support Services of Monterey County.</u>

Individuals holding designated positions shall file their statement of economic interests with the Department of Child Support Services, which will make the statements available(b) Pursuant to Government Code section 81008 and 2 Cal. Code of Regs. section 18730(b)(4), all designated employees shall file statements of economic interests with their agency. Upon receipt of the statement of the Director of Child Support Services, the agency shall make and retain a copy and forward the original of the statement to the code reviewing body. Statements for all other designated employees shall be retained by the agency, which shall make the statements available_ for public inspection and reproduction_pursuant to Government Code section 81008. Upon receipt of the statements for the Director of Child Support Services, the Department shall make and retain copies and forward the original of the statements to the code reviewing body. Statements for all other designated positions shall be retained by the Department.

EXHIBIT APPENDIX B: Disclosure Categories DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

General Provisions Applicable to All Categories

When an individual who holds a member, officer, or employee who holds a designated position is required to disclose investments and sources of income, he or she shall disclose investments in business entities and sources of income which do business in the jurisdiction, plan to do business in the jurisdiction, or have done business in the jurisdiction within the past two years. In addition to other activities, a business entity is doing business within the jurisdiction if it owns real property within the jurisdiction.

When a designated member, officer, or employee<u>an individual</u> who holds a designated position is required to disclose sources of income, he or she shall disclose gifts received from donors located inside as well as outside the jurisdiction.

When a<u>n individual</u>-designated member, officer, or employee who holds a designated position is required to disclose interests in real property, he or she shall disclose the type of real property described below, if it is located in whole or in part within, or not more than two miles outside of the boundaries of within the jurisdiction, or within not more than two miles <u>outside the boundaries</u> of the jurisdiction, or within two miles of any land owned or used by the Department<u>.</u> of Child Support Services.

Such designation must be made in writing and shall include a description of the consultant's duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of the consultant's disclosure requirements. The Director's designation must be filed, in advance of disclosure by the consultant, with the agency's conflict of interest code and also filed with the code reviewing body and must be delivered to the consultant along with a copy of the conflict of interest code and the manual and forms for disclosure (FPPC Form 700).
