WHEREAS, the Greenfield Union School District has recently reviewed its positions, and the duties of each position, and has determined that changes to the current Conflict of Interest Board Bylaw 9270 are necessary;

WHEREAS, the amended Conflict of Interest Board Bylaw 9270 is attached as Exhibit A to this resolution:

WHEREAS, any earlier resolutions, bylaws and/or appendices containing the District's conflict of interest code shall be rescinded and superseded by this resolution and the amended Conflict of Interest Board Bylaw 9270; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Greenfield Union School District Governing Board adopts the amended Conflict of Interest Board Bylaw 9270, including its Appendix of designated employees and disclosure categories.

The Political Reform Act requires that each public agency in California review its Conflict of Interest Code on a biennial basis. Additional language has also been added pursuant to the conflict of interest provisions found in the Government Code and the California Code of Regulations.
