WHEREAS, in order to meet the new federal application guidelines which require the State to include all proposed projects in its initial application for the Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) award, all California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) subrecipients will be required to submit HSGP grant award applications in advance of the release of the FY 2017 HSGP Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO); and

WHEREAS, California subrecipients are to develop their FY 2017 application using their FY 2016 allocation as estimates for project funding, and are to include one or two scalable projects in their advance application that can later be adjusted to accommodate the final FY 2017 allocations;

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that there will be a short State application period due to the anticipated late release of the NOFO; and

WHEREAS, subrecipients will have a short turnaround time (likely 10 days) for submission of scalable project adjustments once the final allocations are released; and

WHEREAS, to apply for the HSGP, County staff need to be designated and authorized to apply for and execute all documents necessary to secure the HSGP grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey, State of California, does hereby authorize the Office of Emergency Services to submit an application for the FY 2017 Homeland Security Grant Program and any amendments thereto with the State of California for the purposes of this grant; and designates and authorizes Monterey County representatives, the appropriate Auditor-Controller staff, Emergency Services

Manager and Emergency Services Planner to execute grant documents for the FY 2017 Homeland Security Grant Program .
