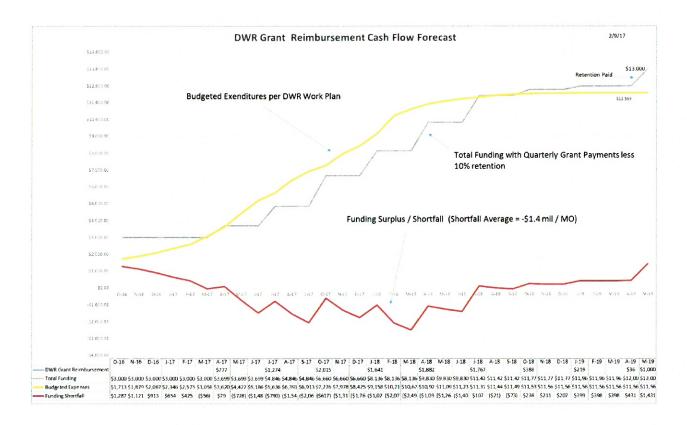
Financial status and forecast

Grant funding from the California Department of Water Resources in the amount of \$10 million was approved in September 2016 via AB 1585 legislation. The Grant Agreement between DWR and MCWRA has been executed and efforts are underway to implement the grant funding. A work plan and schedule describing the use of the grant funds to develop the project is summarized below:

Expenditures as of December 31, 2016

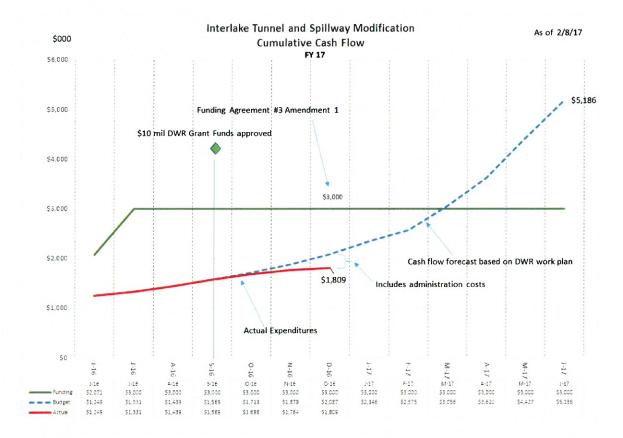
The project has expended approximately \$1.8 million as of 12/31/16.

accordance with the DWR Grant work plan. Reimbursements from the grant funds for work beginning October 1, 2016 are expected to be available before exhausting current funding sources.



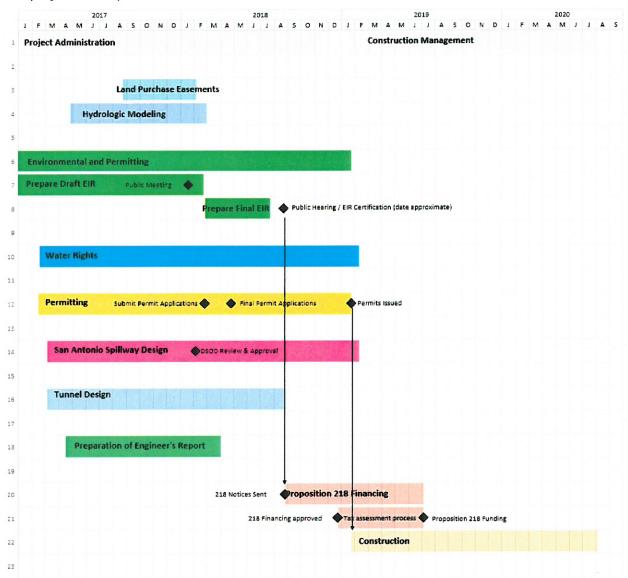

Planning milestones / Decision Points

Pending milestones include:

- Completion of hydrologic modeling using the County's basin model July 2017
- Commencement of preliminary engineering for the tunnel and spillway modification March 2017
- Preliminary meetings with DSOD regarding the spillway modification project May 2017
- Stakeholder workshop April/May 2017

Key decision points include:

- Scope determination for the Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP)
- Identification of funding source for the tunnel project's participation in the HCP
