
































Uninsured Care Options

Option 1-Full scope primary care pilot

Patients meeting the following eligibility criteria may qualify:

- Low-income resident of Monterey County
- 19-64 years old
- Currently uninsured
- Not eligible for any state-funded or private health plan

Covered services:

 Full array of County operated primary care services including lab, diagnostic imaging and limited generic drugs.

Full scope primary care pilot

Medical Costs: \$78 PMPM*

- \$28 PMPM for medical home
- \$50 PMPM ancillary and pharmacy

Annual Cost:

\$936,000 for 1,000 individuals

* per member per month

Option 2 – Full scope primary care pilot and ambulatory specialty services

Patients meeting the following eligibility criteria may qualify:

- Low-income resident of Monterey County
- 19-64 years old
- Currently uninsured
- Not eligible for any state-funded or private health plan

Covered services:

 Full array of County operated primary care and NMC based outpatient specialty services including lab, diagnostic imaging and limited generic drugs

Full scope primary care pilot and ambulatory specialty services

Medical Costs: \$150 PMPM

- \$28 PMPM for medical home
- \$122 PMPM specialty care, ancillary and pharmacy

Annual Cost:

\$1.8 million for 1,000 individuals

Administrative Annual Costs:

\$100,000 to \$200,000 per year

Excluded Services for Option 1 and 2

- Mental Health and Substance Use Recovery
- Inpatient Hospital Services
- Surgery Services
- Medical Equipment and Supplies
- Emergency Room Visits
- Physical and Occupational Therapy
- All out of system care

Option 3 - ViaCare 2.0

- CCAH* administered Medi-Cal like plan
- Estimated costs: \$350 PMPM
- Annual Costs: \$21 million for 5,000 members
- Admin fees and startup costs: TBD
