RECITALS

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 48000 et seq. authorize the California Department of Resources, Recycling and Recovery ("CalRecycle"), to administer various grant programs (grants) in furtherance of the State of California's (state) efforts to reduce, recycle, and reuse solid waste generated in the state, thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding, and management of the grants; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants.

WHEREAS, procedures established by the state and CalRecycle require each Applicant's governing body to certify by resolution its approval of the submittal of grant application to CalRecycle; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Monterey County Board of Supervisors authorizes the submittal of application(s) to CalRecycle for the Local Enforcement Agency grant.

NOW BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Health, or the Assistant Director of Health, is hereby authorized and empowered execute to all grant-related documents on behalf of Monterey County, including, but not limited to, applications, payment requests, agreements, and amendments necessary to secure grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the grant application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these authorizations are effective for three (3) years as of the date of Board approval or as of March 14, 2017, whichever date is earlier, through December 1, 2020.
