WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors and County Administrative Office incurred unexpected and unforeseen expenses due to disasters caused by the winter storms and the Soberanes Fire for which the County may potentially receive partial reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends providing relief for some of the costs for time-sensitive worked performed to protect the health and safety of County residents by replenishing a portion of the cost to the two departments; and

WHEREAS, the expenditures for damages related to the winter storms and the Soberanes Fire can be funded by the Disaster Assistance Assignment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors incurred expenses at mid-year for payment of vacation accruals for employees that separated from the County due to staffing changes in two Supervisorial districts, causing a need to augment their budget; and

WHEREAS, the expenditures for vacation accruals can be funded by the Termination Assignment.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Monterey County Board of Supervisors hereby resolved to approve the following:
