Assessing the needs of the low-income people in Monterey County and develop, maintain, and evaluate community services that empower low-income individuals and families to improve their quality of life.


1) Contract with local non-profit and public agencies for services

Biennial Needs Assessment & Agency Plan


Percent of Monterey County Population Living Below Federal Poverty Line




US Census, ACS 2011-2015 5-Year Estimates

Next Steps

- 2018-2019 Community Action Plan presented for approval by Monterey County Board of Supervisors
- Approved Plan must be delivered to the California Department of Community Services and Development by June 30, 2017.
- This Plan will be used as a guide for the provision of supportive community services to low-income people in Monterey County for Calendar Years 2018-2019.

- MCCAP will release a Request for Proposals (RFP) to community based organizations for provision of services that meet the priorities documented in this plan.
- MCCAP staff will oversee multiple contracts for these services for 2018-2019 and manage data regarding outcomes to be delivered to the State.
- MCCAP Commissioners are able to engage in all processes and provide oversight
