Authorize the Deputy Purchasing Agent for Natividad Medical Center (NMC) or his designee to execute amendment No. 7 to the agreement (A-11786) with Hooper, Lundy & Bookman, PC for legal services with respect to healthcare matters at Natividad Medical Center, extending the agreement an additional one (1) year period (July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018) for a revised full agreement term of April 1, 2010 through June 30, 2018, and adding \$317,000 for a revised total agreement amount not to exceed \$2,452,368.
- b. Authorize the Deputy Purchasing Agent for NMC or his designee to execute up to three
 (3) future amendments to the agreement which do not significantly alter the scope of work and do not cause an increase of more than ten percent (10%) of the original cost of the agreement per each amendment.

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>:

It is recommended the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize the Deputy Purchasing Agent for Natividad Medical Center (NMC) or his designee to execute amendment No. 7 to the agreement (A-11786) with Hooper, Lundy & Bookman, PC for legal services with respect to healthcare matters at Natividad Medical Center, extending the agreement an additional one (1) year period (July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018) for a revised full agreement term of April 1, 2010 through June 30, 2018, and adding \$317,000 for a revised total agreement amount not to exceed \$2,452,368.

Authorize the Deputy Purchasing Agent for NMC or his designee to execute up to three (3) future amendments to the agreement which do not significantly alter the scope of work and do not cause an increase of more than ten percent (10%) of the original cost of the agreement per each amendment.

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

County Counsel has reviewed and approved this amendment No. 7 as to legal form and risk provisions, and the Auditor-Controller has reviewed and approved as to payment provisions. This amendment No. 7 has also been reviewed and approved by NMC's Finance Committee on March 23, 2017 and by its Board of Trustees on April 7, 2017.

FINANCING:

The cost for this amendment No. 7 is \$317,000 all of which shall be included in the Fiscal Year 2017-18 Recommended Budget. There is no impact to the General Fund.
