- a. Approved the Water Resources Agency FY 2016-17 budget amendment to increase revenue and appropriations in the amount of \$80,000 for Fund 130-Nacimiento Hydro-Electric Operations and Maintenance and \$25,000 for Fund 122-Zone 9 Reclamation Ditch to pay invoices as a result of the unexpected flooding that occurred in the Winter of 2017;
- b. Authorized the Auditor-Controller to amend the Monterey County Water Resources Agency's FY 2016-17 Adopted Budget and increase revenue and appropriations by \$80,000 in Fund 930-8267-130-Nacimiento Hydro-Electric Operations and Maintenance, WRA 022 financed by unassigned fund balance in Fund 930-8267-130-Naci Hydro-Electric Operations and Maintenance-WRA 022 (4/5th vote required); and

WHEREAS, the Hydro-Electric Plant Fiscal Year 2016-17 budget was based on continued drought (low reservoir elevation) conditions allowing only Unit 2 operation (the smaller generating unit) and a low level valve to maintain minimum fisheries release;

WHEREAS, generator testing and increased labor related to operating;

WHEREAS, expenditures for Unit 1 in Fiscal Year 2016-17 exceeded the monies programmed as a result of the intermittent operation and shut-down of Unit 1, occasioned by high water at the Hydro outlet, and the need for replacement of a power pole and testing of a generator, followed by continuous operation starting in March 30, 2017;

WHEREAS, two pump stations in Agency Zone 9 – Reclamation Ditch were flooded and sustained damage in January and February 2017, and a nearby levee overtopped, requiring the need for repairs; and

WHEREAS, levee repair, pump rental, fuel and associated labor and portable pump operation and maintenance costs are not normally incurred in the Zone 9 – Reclamation Ditch budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Monterey County Water Resources Agency Board of Supervisors hereby

- a. Approves the Water Resources Agency FY 2016-17 budget amendment to increase revenue and appropriations in the amount of \$80,000 for Fund 130-Nacimiento Hydro-Electric Operations and Maintenance and \$25,000 for Fund 122-Zone 9 Reclamation Ditch to pay invoices as a result of the unexpected flooding that occurred in the Winter of 2017; and
- b. Authorizes the Auditor-Controller to amend the Monterey County Water Resources Agency's FY 2016-17 Adopted Budget and increase revenue and appropriations by \$80,000 in Fund 930-8267-130-Nacimiento Hydro-Electric Operations and Maintenance, WRA 022 financed by unassigned fund balance in Fund 930-8267-130-Naci Hydro-Electric Operations and Maintenance-WRA 022 (4/5th vote required);
- c. Authorizes the Auditor-Controller to amend the Monterey County Water Resources Agency's FY 2016-17 Adopted Budget and increase revenue and appropriations by \$25,000 in Fund 930-8267-122-Zone 9 Reclamation Ditch, WRA 012 financed by unassigned fund balance in Fund 930-8267-122-Zone 9 Reclamation Ditch-WRA 012 (4/5th vote required);
