WHEREAS, the Monterey County Water Resources Agency has historically leased portions of its property at and around the San Antonio Reservoir in Monterey County and the Nacimiento Reservoir in San Luis Obispo County for livestock grazing; and,

WHEREAS, the Agency's grazing lease program is intended to implement management methods that meet the Agency's conservation goals of protecting the water quality and quantity of both reservoirs, and the Agency wishes to lease its grazing lands to bidders experienced and qualified to accomplish those goals; and,

WHEREAS, the Agency wishes to establish a process for the qualification of potential grazing land lessees, public bidding of those leases, and a schedule of grazing lease contract and program fees that seek to recoup the Agency's costs of implementing its grazing lease program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Monterey County Water Resources Agency Board of Supervisors that:
