

ELECTRONIC FILING ORDINANCE

Monterey County Elections

Proposal to amend Chapter 1.10 of the Monterey County Code

- This proposal would amend Chapter 1.10 of the Monterey County Code to require electronic filing of campaign disclosure statements and other reports required pursuant to the Political Reform Act with the Registrar of Voters of Monterey County.
- Allowed pursuant to Government Code Section 84615

GC§ 84615 Required Findings

- The filing system operates securely
 - Exists on a secured load balanced server,
 - Website encrypted
 - Physical locations operate with redundant systems for power, fire suppression, and internet access
 - Redundant Enterprise level firewalls
 - 24 hour internal monitoring
 - All users have unique log in credentials
- The filing system operates effectively
 - Monterey County has partnered with NetFile since 2011
- The filing system does not unduly burden filers
 - Training and assistance is readily available
- The filing system is offered free of charge to filers
- The filing system is accessible for searches on the Elections website
- Kiosk with non-redacted forms will be publicly available at the Elections office
