The monthly expense allowance for incumbents of classes identified in A.10.1 Department Heads Designated shall be fifty-four dollars and seventeen cents (54.17) and the monthly expense allowance for incumbents of all other classes in Units X and Y shall be forty-five

dollars and eighty-four cents (45.84). Expense allowance shall be paid on the second pay period of each month.
