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Sales Tax Collection on Internet Sales	Congress is expected to consider legislation which would allow counties to enforce their existing sales tax laws regardless of whether a purchase is made in a store, online or through a catalog retailer. Online retailers are now required to collect state sales tax only for states where the retailer has a physical presence, such as a store or distribution center.	
Voting Rights Act	The Supreme Court struck down Section 4 of the Voting Rights Act in <i>Shelby County v. Holder</i> . Section 4 contains the coverage formula that determines which jurisdictions are subject to the federal preclearance requirement in Section 5. Congress must enact legislation to create a new coverage formula in order for Section 5 to have any effect.
