In addition, he helped organize the 1963 March on Washington during which he delivered his eloquent and moving "I Have a Dream" speech; and

WHEREAS, Dr. King's life will always shine as a light for those without hope and will represent liberation from injustice that resonates with all marginalized groups. He is an example to be emulated by all who care about their fellow human beings, regardless of race, religion, sexual orientation, class, immigration status or nationality; and
