WHEREAS, County Service Area (CSA) 15 Serra Village/Toro Park is located off California State Route 68, approximately two miles west of the City of Salinas; and

WHEREAS, CSA 15 has many Monterey pine, coast live oak, and native sycamore trees throughout the subdivision with some located near community sidewalks and the roots of these trees have broken and/or raised sections of the sidewalks creating trip hazards; and

WHEREAS, in addition to said tree root damage, sidewalk damage occurred from an uprooted tree during the 2017 winter storm and from a private construction project; and

WHEREAS, at the time of FY 17-18 budget creation, the full cost for the CSA 15 sidewalk project was unknown and an approximation of \$29,211 was added to the budget; and

WHEREAS, in July of 2017, a job order contracting (JOC) project was initiated with the Gordian Group and Granite Construction resulting in a quote for construction costs totaling \$61,530; and

WHEREAS, the requested appropriation of \$35,000 would fund the sidewalk repairs in CSA 15; and

WHEREAS, this Project meets County of Monterey Strategic Initiatives related to Infrastructure and Public Safety as safety will be increased by repairing the damaged sidewalks, minimizing trip hazards, and infrastructure shall be maintained by limiting future sidewalk deterioration; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Monterey County Board of Supervisors hereby resolves to approve the following:

Authorize the Auditor-Controller to amend the FY 2017-18 adopted budget for County Service Area 15 Toro Park/Serra Village, Fund 056-3000-8198-RMA052, by increasing appropriations in the amount of \$35,000 where Fund 056 Unassigned Fund Balance is the financing source (4/5th vote required).
