SUBJECT: TriTech Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) Program

- 2. Background: Monterey County (MOCO) Emergency Communications Department (ECD) provides Computer Aided Dispatch system access and connectivity to all Monterey County and local public safety agencies. MOCO entered into a service contract with TriTech Software Systems in December 2015 to replace their Tiburon Computer Aided Dispatch and mobile data terminal system.
- 3. Based on the information currently available, I have determined it is most beneficial for United States Army Garrison Presidio of Monterey (USAG POM) to receive Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) services for USAG POM's Emergency Communication Center (ECC) from the MOCO ECD. MOCO CAD services would allow USAG POM ECC to provide interoperability with community partners.
- 4. USAG POM is working diligently to determine the best method to formalize an agreement with MOCO for provision of MOCO CAD services. USAG POM recognizes that an agreement for MOCO CAD services must be formally approved by the Monterey County Board of Supervisors before such services are provided.
- 5. We look forward to our potential partnership with MOCO ECD to provide a better service to our Army customers and surrounding community partners.
