FEMA Eligibility - Ability to complete the project within the FEMA timelines for reimbursement

| 12 | 1- Eligible Costs that can be completed without an extension |
| 9 | 2- extension < 1 year |
| 6 | 3- extension 1-2 years |
| 3 | 4- full extension up to 3 years (max extension) |

Project Readiness – Ability to complete the project with least amount of design and permitting time/costs

|----|--|
| 15 | 1- Construction ready |
| 12 | 2- Minor design (in house), no permits |
| 9 | 3- In house design, minor permits (no hearing or agreements) |
| 6 | 4- Contract Design, minor permits (no hearing or agreements) |
| 3 | 5- Contract Design, permits require hearing and/or agreements (e.g. ITP) |

Public Safety – Project reduces risk of impact to health and safety

|----|---|
| 30 | 1- Provides critical access for safety operations (e.g. emergency response) |
| 24 | 2- Eliminates risk of liability or exposure to hazards (road safety, hazardous materials) |
| 18 | 3- Significantly reduces risk of liability or exposure to hazards |
| 12 | 4- Minimally reduces risk of liability or exposure to hazards |
| 6 | 5- No reduction of risk of liability or exposure to hazards |

Critical Function/Access – Accessibility to significant populations (homes or facility), significant traffic, critical for County economy

|----|---|
| 25 | 1- Sole access to significant population or major employment center. Directly benefits all resident. ADT >7500 |
| 20 | 2- Primary access to significant population or major employment center. Project affects the entire County population and has a major effect on County Economy. ADT 3001-7499 |
| 15 | 3- Primary access but limited population or employment center. Project affects a large region or significant portion of the County population, including some industries. ADT 1000-3000 |
| 10 | 4- Project affects a small region or portion of the County. Secondary Access, ADT 250-1000 |
| 5 | 5- Project is limited to a very specific area of the County and has no noticeable affect outside the immediate location. Secondary access, ADT 0-250. |
