- b. Direct the Auditor Controller to appropriate approximately \$125,000 into the FY2017-18 budget; and
- c. Direct the Human Resources Department to implement the changes in the Advantage HRM System.

WHEREAS, the Resource Management Agency (RMA) requested that the Human Resources Department (HRD) conduct a wage study to compare Monterey County's Engineering classifications with those of comparable agencies since the last study was conducted in 1985:

WHEREAS, this wage study resulted in Board of Supervisors Resolution No. 17-235, adjusting salaries for the RMA Engineering classifications;

WHEREAS, HRD's adjusted salary ranges of selected RMA Engineering classes failed to include comparable Agency Engineering/Hydrologist classes;

WHEREAS, the Agency established parity in 2008 between the RMA's Engineering classes and the Agency's Engineering and Hydrologist classes;

WHEREAS, salary alignment with comparable agencies is a critical component in the Water Resources Agency (Agency) and County's ability to competitively attract, recruit and retain qualified employees;

WHEREAS, a situation has been created in which the Agency is unable to competitively attract, recruit and retain qualified employees working in positions equivalent to those at RMA;

WHEREAS, Approval of these recommendations provides for alignment of the salary ranges for the Agency's Engineering/Hydrologist classifications as indicated with comparable County Departments, and other agencies;

NOW, THEREFOR, the Monterey County Board of Supervisors hereby resolves to approve the following:
