Approve the Bingo License Application for American Legion Post 593 pursuant to Chapter 7.08 of the Monterey County Code effective April 3, 2018 through April 2, 2019.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve the Bingo License Application for American Legion Post 593 pursuant to Chapter 7.08 of the Monterey County Code effective April 3, 2018 through April 2, 2019.

SUMMARY:

On Tuesday, March 13, 2018, the American Legion Post 593 submitted a Bingo License application to the Clerk of the Board with the requisite \$50.00 application fee. The Clerk of the Board transmitted a memo along with a copy of the application to the Monterey County Sheriff's Office on Friday, March 16, 2018 for a ten-day review, pursuant to Chapter 7.08 of the Monterey County Code.

The Sheriff's office has reviewed the materials and provided a written response to the Clerk of the Board with no objections to the issuance of the bingo license.

Pursuant to Chapter 7.08 of the Monterey County Code, the Monterey County Board of Supervisors is the responsible body for the issuance of Bingo Licenses. Upon approval by the Board of Supervisors, the Clerk of the Board will issue the applicant the Bingo License effective April 3, 2018 through April 2, 2019, a draft of which is attached to this board report and will notify the Sheriff's Department of the final board action pertaining to this application.
