recommends that the Monterey County Board of Supervisors:

- a. Adopt a Resolution to Amend Personnel Policies and Practices Resolution (PPPR) No. 98-394, Appendix A, to adjust the salary range for the following classifications: Senior Water Resources Engineer, Senior Water Resources Hydrologist, Associate Water Resources Engineer, Associate Water Resources Hydrologist, Associate Water Resources Biologist, Water Resources Engineer, Water Resources Hydrologist, and Water Resources Biologist, as indicated in the attached resolution, effective retroactively to the pay period beginning July 22, 2017;
- b. Authorize the Auditor-Controller's Office to incorporate approved appropriation and estimated revenue modifications to the FY-2017-18 Budget, and the County Administrative Office to reflect these approved changes in the Monterey County Water Resources Agency (MCWRA) FY 2018-19 Adopted Budget;
- c. Authorize the Auditor-Controller to make payment to impacted incumbent

MCWRA employees, retroactive to July 22, 2017; and d. Direct the Human Resources Department to implement the changes in the Advantage HRM System.
