- (b) Monterey County has a general plan which demonstrates a long-term commitment to agricultural land conservation. This commitment is reflected in the goals, objectives, policies, and implementation measures of the plan, as they relate to the area, of Monterey County where the Agricultural Conservation Easement acquisition is proposed.
- (c) Without conservation, the land proposed for protection is likely to be converted to nonagricultural use in the foreseeable future.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE County of Monterey HEREBY:

- a. Supports the Ag Land Trust Agricultural Conservation Easement (ACE) proposal to the California Department of Conservation Sustainable Agricultural Lands Conservation (SALC) Program for grant funding for the acquisition of an Agricultural Conservation Easement (ACE) over 175 acres of the Mothershed Farm; and
- b. Supports the Ag Land Trust application to receive grant funds from the State of California Department of Conservation Sustainable Agricultural Lands Conservation Program (SALC) to acquire an Agricultural Conservation Easement (ACE) over the Mothershed Farm which consists of one (1) 175 acre parcel situated at the intersection of Blanco and Cooper Road, ½ mile east of the City limits of Maria in Monterey County (APN Nos. 414-021-002-000) to place said parcels into an ACE to conserve priority agricultural land resources.
