



Monterey County Board of Supervisors

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Board Order

Upon motion of Supervisor Adams, seconded by Supervisor Salinas and carried by those members present, the Board of Supervisors hereby:

- a. Received update on the status of the 2017 Winter Storm damage repair projects, including status of funding, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) reimbursements, and 2018 winterization.
- b. Provided direction for maintaining maintenance effort on Measure X and SB1; to consider basic safety improvements as critical criteria, as well as access to communities of residents; maintain functionality of the roads; to look at projects that maximize or increase probability of return on our FEMA match. To look at average daily traffic to maximize improvements on roads that are most heavily used for regional circulation and then projects which support non-critical or recreational functions. Directed staff talk with City of Salinas and evaluate bonding of Measure X.
- c. Directed CIC to have an emergency meeting for prioritization of projects and return February 13, 2018 with updates.
