Agricultural Commissioner	<ul> <li>Pesticide use enforcement</li> <li>Weights and Measures program</li> <li>Responsible for field worker safety</li> <li>Random surveillance</li> <li>Contract with CalCannabis Cultivation and Licensing (CDFA)</li> </ul>				
Sheriff	<ul><li>Law enforcement to combat illegal cannabis growing</li><li>Support coordination of multi-agency and department search warrant service</li></ul>				
County Counsel	<ul> <li>State of CA Cannabis Agencies County Point of Contact, which includes communications with the state agencies concerning compliance and enforcement issues</li> <li>Legal support to Agricultural Commissioner, RMA and Environmental Health on their enforcement functions</li> <li>Assist in obtaining inspection warrants</li> </ul>				
District Attorney	<ul> <li>Investigate alleged crimes in cooperation with law enforcement, and file criminal charges, where applicable</li> <li>Criminal prosecution</li> <li>Civil and Environmental prosecution</li> </ul>				
Resource Management Agency (Code Enforcement)	<ul> <li>Enforcement of land use and building code compliance</li> <li>Receive complaints or based on surveillance and/or observation</li> <li>Inspect relevant land use regulations</li> </ul>				
Health Department (Environmental Health)	<ul> <li>Enforcement of State of CA Health and Safety Code and MCC regulations</li> <li>Conduct annual inspections</li> </ul>				
Outside Agencies	<ul> <li>Collaborate with County departments or Program Manager to support enforcement activities</li> </ul>
