Dear Mr. Chardavoyne:

We have reviewed the inundation maps submitted on December 22, 2017, for Nacimiento Dam. The submittal includes: (1) the map dated October 30, 2014 for the main dam, and (2) the map dated December 19, 2017 for the gated spillway.

We have identified the gated spillway as the only critical appurtenant structure and determined that the submitted inundation map is consistent with the direction contained in the *Federal Guidelines for Inundation Mapping of Flood Risks associated with Dam Incidents and Failures* (FEMA P-946, 2013). Therefore, the inundation map associated with the failure of the gated spillway is approved.

However, we found that the estimated flood elevations noted on the inundation map for the main dam at various locations downstream does not adequately convey the expected flood depths in accordance with FEMA P-946. Some of these areas are inhabited; therefore, your submitted inundation map for the main dam is judged to be insufficient for emergency preparedness. This inundation map needs to be revised and resubmitted for review. The California Governor's Office of Emergency Services requires all inundation maps for a dam system to be approved and incorporated into the EAP to consider it complete, and they will not initiate their review per Division 3, section 6161(b) of the California Water Code until the EAP is complete.

Please submit a plan and schedule to complete this map for our review by July 1, 2018. All new maps must be prepared in accordance with Title 23, Division 2, Chapter 1, Article 6 of the California Code of Regulations.

Since 1991, the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District (MPWMD) has carried out a comprehensive *Mitigation Program* that addresses the environmental impacts associated with providing water to the community from the Carmel River and Seaside Groundwater Basins. The program focuses on gathering baseline information on hydrology and water quality, the Carmel River steelhead population, the Carmel River riparian habitat, and the Carmel River Lagoon to inform management decisions about needed projects. The *Mitigation Program* is a required component of the MPWMD Water Allocation Program Environmental Impact Report that was certified by the District Board in November 1990. Each year, a detailed Annual Report is prepared that describes the District's specific mitigation activities, data collected, and results.
