WHEREAS, Esmeralda Montenegro-Owen began as Executive Director of YOSAL in July of 2018, expressing her passion for music education and its benefits to youth, as well as her desire to establish stable funding for the program; and

WHEREAS, YOSAL runs year-round, with both school year and summer programs; and

WHEREAS, teachers of YOSAL strive to provide a range of opportunities for the participants to feel proud of their accomplishments, through performances, field trips, and camps, which results in an improvement in math and language skills, and school attendance; and

WHEREAS, YOSAL picks students up at 10 locations throughout Salinas via bus and allow time for homework and snack time, which eliminates barriers for youth to become involved with the program; and

WHEREAS, YOSAL provides the youth of Salinas with a positive avenue into academic and social success—keeping them away from gangs, violence and danger; and

WHEREAS, YOSAL promotes peace and education throughout Salinas by providing school age children with a safe environment to learn responsibility, collaboration, and respect through music; and
