**Committee Responsibilities:**

1. Provide review and recommendations concerning new strategic policy initiatives, priority projects, and/or changes in existing policies regarding health, housing and human services activities in addition to collective impact initiatives to address homelessness, gang violence prevention, governing for racial equity and other items as it relates to health, housing and human services.
2. Review and make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors regarding legislative, budgetary, regulatory, and priority grant issues which could impact or benefit the County.
3. Provide recommendations to the Health, Housing and Human Services Committee staff and County departments to strategically direct and coordinate activities in alignment with the goals of the County’s Strategic Initiatives and in support of efforts to address community needs as they relate to health, housing and human services.
