On the Board of Supervisor's Agenda on October 2, 2018, Legistar Item No. 18-986, addressed the Elections Department's item to authorize the Registrar of Voters to provide election services and appoint candidates to the offices where the number of persons who filed did not exceed the number of offices to be filled relating to the November 6, 2018 Statewide General Election. The language in the Board Report title stated, "Adopt a Resolution to:" before the Title of the item. This was a clerical error and should have been omitted as there was no requirement for a resolution for this item. It should be noted that the typo, "Adopt a Resolution to:" was not added in the Recommendation section only the Title section. Since the Clerk of the Board creates the Board Order from the Recommendation section only (and not from the Title), then Board Order did not contain this language.
