FACILITIES FROM THE SALE OF TAX-EXEMPT BONDS NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at 10:30 a.m.,

or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, on October 23, 2018, at Monterey County Government Center, Board of Supervisors' Chambers, 168 W.
