It is believed that compliance to the proposed standards is unrealistic, unnecessary, and strictly imposed for a new revenue source. Many indicated they will attend the

has not been taken into consideration is the money it will take to bring many of these well systems into the strict compliance proposed. As it is, the well maintenance and testing currently required is costly enough. To add insult to injury is going to cause financial hardship for many.
