2. a. Homeless Encampments at Manzanita Park

Brett Fulgoni, interim operations manager, accompanied by Cam Sanchez, management specialist presented a power point of the homeless encampments at Manzanita Park.

County Counsel indicated for historical purposes, six months to a year ago the sheriff's department had evicted a large homeless encampment from behind Prunedale shopping center and is possible they may have been displaced here.

County Counsel requested Chair Hertlein reopen item 2c as Commissioner Getzelman had a suggestion to move the meeting to the Lockwood Community Center instead of the De Anza Room at San Lorenzo Park.

b. Toro Trails Task Force and schedule
