ADDITIONAL LUAC COMMENTS

- 1) Matt Shea In favor. Rigorous permitting, a process that keeps outside interests out and keeps it local, security measures, and easier enforcement make this a good program. The program as proposed alleviates most of the concerns of the audience. Tax revenue should include local projects.
- 2) Diane Miller Agrees with Matt and adds WATER is serious issue and the county should look into ways of measuring the impact.
- 3) Jack Galante Legalization and permitting will mimimize impact on community, F40 and RC zoning are better suited and should be added. Dedicated Tax dollars to community should be required.
- 4) Kathy Herbermann Against "RDR" zoning being allowed. Wants more clarity on sunset of project or evaluation process.
- 5) Sarah Haussermann Re-stated all points made in previous meeting and today's meeting: No permits to operators with criminal records, more dedicated law enforcement, concern for shared roads and parking, No lighting, No shared water usage, water is huge concern especially on shared systems, grows should have onsite operator, review of program should include LUAC and Community, no outside interests being able to move into area, concern over permit being attached to operator and not land. Believes strong enforcement of size should be enforced and not allowed over size of previous medicinal permitting size. Reiterated dedicated tax dollars to community.
