Per Capita Program

\$185,000,000 available on per capita basis

Percentage of State population, or \$400,000 minimum

County allocation is split with all agencies in unincorporated areas that manage parks and open space.

33 Agencies (City, County, Special Districts) in Monterey County identified by State.

6 report managing parks and open space (LAFCO)

\$2,000,000 allocation based on population percentage
