WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR entered into Professional Services Agreement No. A-12261 with County on April 15, 2014 (hereinafter, "Agreement") to provide Surface Mining and Reclamation Act (SMARA) annual inspections (hereinafter, "services") through December 31, 2017 for an amount not to exceed \$389,720; and

WHEREAS, Agreement was amended by the Parties on August 18, 2014 (hereinafter, "Amendment No. 1", including Exhibit A-1 - Reallocation of Compliance Review Budget for 2014 and 2015) to reallocate funding between tasks identified in the Agreement with no extension to the term and with no increase in the not to exceed amount; and

WHEREAS, Agreement was amended by the Parties on December 4, 2017 (hereinafter, "Amendment No. 2") to extend the term for one (1) additional year through December 31, 2018 with no increase in the not to exceed amount; and

WHEREAS, Agreement was amended by the Parties on December 4, 2018 (hereinafter, "Amendment No. 3") to extend the term for three (3) additional months through March 31, 2019 with no increase in the not to exceed amount; and

WHEREAS, County has a continued need for services beyond the anticipated five (5) year Agreement term allowed per Request for Proposals (RFP) #10443; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have identified additional services in the amount of \$163,918 to be completed by CONTRACTOR for 2018 and 2019 mine inspections, use permit compliance review and technical assistance for compliance with State regulations; and

WHEREAS, additional time is necessary to allow completion of additional services by CONTRACTOR and to allow County staff time to prepare and process a new RFP; and

WHEREAS, County has identified unused Agreement funding in the amount \$76,825; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to reallocate a portion of the unused funding in the amount of \$61,398 for costs associated with 2018 mine inspections and technical assistance services; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to reallocate the remaining portion of the existing funding in the amount of \$15,427 for costs associated with 2019 mine inspections, use permit compliance review and technical assistance services; and

WHEREAS, the Parties agree that new additional funding in the amount of \$87,093 is required to allow CONTRACTOR to complete the remaining unfunded services associated with the completion of 2019 mine inspections, use permit compliance review and technical assistance services; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to further amend the Agreement to extend the term for one (1) additional year to March 31, 2020, reallocate funding in the amount of \$76,825, and to increase the amount by \$87,093 for a total amount not to exceed \$476,813 to allow CONTRACTOR to continue to provide services identified in the Agreement and as amended by this Amendment No. 4.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Amend the first sentence of Paragraph 1, "Services to be Provided", to read as follows:

The County hereby engages CONTRACTOR to perform, and CONTRACTOR hereby agrees to perform, the services described in Exhibits A, A-1, and A-2 in conformity with the terms of this Agreement.

2. Amend Paragraph 2, "Payments by County", to read as follows:

County shall pay the CONTRACTOR in accordance with the payment provisions set forth in Exhibits A, A-1, and A-2, subject to the limitations set forth in this Agreement. The total amount payable by County to CONTRACTOR under this Agreement shall not exceed the sum of \$476,813.

3. Amend the first sentence of Paragraph 3, "Term of Agreement", to read as follows:

The term of this Agreement is from April 1, 2014 to March 31, 2020, unless sooner terminated pursuant to the terms of this Agreement.

- 4. Amend Paragraph 4, "Additional Provisions/Exhibits" to add "Exhibit A-2, Scope of Services/Payment Provisions".
- 5. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement, including all Exhibits thereto, remain unchanged and in full force.
- 6. This Amendment No. 4 and all previous amendments shall be attached to the Agreement and incorporated therein as if fully set forth in the Agreement.
- 7. The recitals to this Amendment No. 4 are incorporated into the Agreement and this Amendment No. 4.

- a.if the auto is replaced with a "hybrid" auto or an auto powered solely by electricity or natural gas, we will pay an additional 10%, to a maximum of \$2,500, of the "non-hybrid" auto's actual cash value or replacement cost, whichever is less.
- b. The auto must be replaced and a copy of a bill of sale or new lease agreement received by us within 60 calendar days of the date of "loss,"

c. Regardless of the number of autos deemed a total loss, the most we wilt pay under this Hybrid, Electric, or Natural Gas Vehicle Payment Coverage provision for any one "loss" is \$10,000.

For the purposes of the coverage provision,

- a. A "non-hybrid" auto is defined as an auto that uses only an internal combustion engine to move the auto but does not include autos powered solely by electricity or natural gas.
- b. A "hybrid" auto is defined as an auto with an internal combustion engine and one or more electric motors; and that uses the internal combustion engine and one or more electric motors to move the auto, or the internal combustion engine to charge one or more electric motors, which move the auto,

in the event of a total loss to an "auto" for which Comprehensive, Specified Causes of Loss, or Collision coverages are provided under this Coverage Form, then such Physical Damage Coverages are amended to add the following:

In addition to the actual cash value of the "auto", we will pay up to \$1,000 for vinyl vehicle wraps which are displayed on the covered "auto" at the time of total loss. Regardless of the number of autos deemed a total loss, the most we will pay under this Vehicle Wrap Coverage provision for any one "loss" is \$5,000. For purposes of this coverage provision, signs or other graphics painted or magnetically affixed to the vehicle are not considered vehicle wraps.
