AMENDMENT #1 TO AGREEMENT

AMENDMENT #1 TO AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN COUNTY OF MONTEREY & WESTERN STATE DESIGN, INC.

THIS AMENDMENT is made to the AGREEMENT for scheduled maintenance and emergency repairs as needed for washers and dryers by and between WESTERN STATE DESIGN, INC., hereinafter "CONTRACTOR", and the County of Monterey, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "County".

WHEREAS, the County and CONTRACTOR originally entered into this Agreement on November 16, 2017 with a Not to Exceed amount of \$60,000.00 and a term date ending on November 9, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the County and CONTRACTOR wish to increase the AGREEMENT by \$60,000.00 for a new Not to Exceed sum of \$120,000.00 and extend the term of the Agreement two (2) additional years through November 9, 2021; and

WHEREAS, as of August 6, 2019, CONTRACTOR changed its legal entity name and is presently conducting business in the name of WESTERN STATE DESIGN, INC., and

NOW THEREFORE, the County and CONTRACTOR hereby agree to amend the AGREEMENT in the following manner:

- 1. Section 1., "PAYMENT PROVISIONS" shall be amended by removing, "The total amount payable by County to CONTRACTOR under this Agreement is not to exceed the sum of \$60,000.00", and replacing it with, "The total amount payable by County to CONTRACTOR under this Agreement is not to exceed the sum of \$120,000.00".
- 2. Section 3., "TERM OF AGREEMENT" shall be amended by removing, "The term of this Agreement is from November 10, 2017 to November 9, 2019" and replacing it with, "The term of this Agreement is from November 10, 2017 to November 9, 2021".
- 3. In all places within the AGREEMENT, and any amendment thereto, any reference to ENVIRO STAR, INC. DBA WESTERN STATE DESIGN, INC. is hereby replaced with WESTERN STATE DESIGN, INC.
- 4. EXHIBIT A Scope of Services shall be amended by adding Exhibit A-1 per Amendment #1 attached hereto.
- 5. Except as provided herein, all remaining terms, conditions and provisions of the AGREEMENT are unchanged and unaffected by this AMENDMENT and shall continue in full force and effect as set forth in the AGREEMENT.

Scope of Services / Payment Provisions

A. SCOPE OF SERVICES

In addition to services previously outlined in Exhibit A the following apply:

A.1 CONTRACTOR shall provide services and staff, and otherwise do all things necessary for or incidental to the performance of work, as set forth below:

Purchase and installation of washer and/or dryer as necessary. Replacement of parts and motor, etc. Receive equipment and offload at customer's site, Rig equipment and move into place, Level, bolt and grout to Manufacturer's Specifications, Final connections to existing utilities within 3' from the points of connection, Provide equipment startup and operational training.

B. PAYMENT PROVISIONS
