

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Adoption of Annex M - Electrical Power Disruption Plan *and* Annex Z - Winter Storm Response Plan are significant milestones in the County of Monterey's extensive efforts to create a more resilient Monterey County by prioritizing life safety, the reduction of suffering, protection of property, protection of the environment, continuity and restoration of basic services; and assurance of timely community and economic resiliency as they relate to winter storms and disruption of the electrical system.

WHEREAS, the Authorities of these Annexes are subject to the Monterey County, California Code of Ordinances, Title 2 – Administration, Chapter 2.68 - Emergency Procedures and Organization; and

WHEREAS, the County of Monterey complies with both federal and state guidance to use the National Incident Management System (NIMS) and the Standardized Emergency Management System (SEMS); and

WHEREAS, the County of Monterey has incorporated the Federal Emergency Management Agency's "Whole Community" approach to creating engaged and resilient communities by which we can understand the unique and diverse needs of our population including its demographics, values, norms, networks and relationships. These values are reflected in the Annexes; and

WHEREAS, the Annexes address hazards and vulnerabilities in alignment with the 2014 Monterey County Operational Area Emergency Operations Plan and 2016 Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the County of Monterey has reviewed the Annexes and affirms that the Annexes will be updated no less than every 3 years upon adoption.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors does hereby officially adopt and promulgate the Monterey County Operational Area Emergency Operations Plan Annex M- Electrical Power Disruption Plan *and* Annex Z - Winter Storm Response Plan approved by the Monterey County Operational Area Disaster Council October 30, 2019.


