WHEREAS, the findings of the compensation study found the Environmental Health Specialist I entry level classification to be 10.71% below market; and

WHEREAS, the Human Resources Department and Health Department agree to bring the salary of the Environmental Health Specialist I to the market average; and

**WHEREAS**, the actions require the Personnel Policies and Practices Resolution (PPPR) No. 98-394 Appendix A to adjust the salary range of the classification of Environmental Health Specialist I as indicated below, effective January 4, 2020;
