Limited income means difficult choices....





- > Homelessness


## Older Adult Population continues to grow!

Currently, more than 1 in 6 Monterey County residents are Older Adults


73,810 are 60+ years old

By 2030, 1 in 4 residents will be Seniors




## Rising Population = Rising Service Needs


